

BULLCREEK LEEMING JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB (INC)

The Bullcreek Leeming Junior Football Club (Inc.) is an affiliated Club within the East Fremantle Junior Football Council.

1 OBJECTIVES

1.1 The objectives for the Club are:

- (a) The provision of facilities and opportunities for children to play junior football.
- (b) The provision of opportunities for parents to participate in sport with their children.
- (c) The creation of an atmosphere in which the acquisition of skills within the child's capabilities and the enjoyment of playing the game are at least as important as the games outcome.

2 ORGANISATION

2.1 Players will be grouped into divisions according to their age. This has been amended to coincide with the applicable school year. These changes will be introduced from Auskick and "9's and "10's" this year only.

2.2 Each team requires:

- (a) A Coach.
- (b) A Manager whose duties involve looking after equipment, jumpers and assisting supervising the team each game and to appoint a Social Committee Liaison representative.
- (c) A First Aid Attendant.
- (d) From 13's onwards teams also require a boundary umpire, runner and interchange steward
- (e) Canteen assistants. (Rotated through parents.)
- (f) Parent support on game day to assist with various duties including setting-up and clearing ovals and goal umpiring.

2.3 As parents have varying demands on their time, it is essential that more than one person in each team be familiar with each task. **NO PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE IS NECESSARY** to fill any of these positions as advice will be provided at the beginning of, and during, the season to help the inexperienced.

2.4 Club fixtures are played on either Saturday or Sunday. Home grounds for the season are Beasley and Peter Ellis Ovals, Leeming.

2.5 Team training sessions will be at the discretion of each team coach and manager. There will be some restriction due to lack of availability of grounds. Information in this regard will be advised by either the coach or team manager.

2.6 The Club seeks sponsorship as this enables fees for players to be kept to a minimum. Fundraising and social events are conducted through the season and your support is requested at that time.

3 REGISTRATION

- 3.1 **REGISTRATION DAY WILL BE SUNDAY, 21 FEBRUARY 2010 FROM 9.00AM TO 1.00PM IN THE HALL AT BEASLEY OVAL, LEEMING.**
- 3.2 A registration form must be completed for each player and **signed by a parent. FEES MUST BE PAID** before a player will be placed in a team. Registrations not accompanied by fees **WILL NOT** be accepted.
- 3.3 Players are to be registered on 21 February as we expect an influx of players especially in the younger age groups. **PLEASE REGISTER ON TIME TO ENSURE TEAM PLACEMENT.**
- 3.4 **ONLY NEW PLAYERS JOINING THE CLUB ARE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE A BIRTH CERTIFICATE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.**
- 3.5 Late registrations **WILL NOT** be accepted after 30 June.
Please note: Registration may be closed if too many registrations are received.
- 3.6 Fees for the 2010 season are as follows:

9's to 17's	\$125.00+\$10 EF levy per child =\$135 for one child \$215.00+\$10 EF levy per child =\$235 for 2 children from the one family \$270.00+\$10 EF levy per child =\$300, \$310 or \$320 depending on the number of children in excess of 3 or more children from the one family
Auskick	\$85.00

The increase in fees is in lieu of having a raffle fundraiser in 2010.

Note: FEES INCLUDE THE COST OF INSURANCE, JUMPERS, EQUIPMENT, TEAM PHOTO, PAYMENT OF UMPIRE AND GROUND FEES

- 3.7 All players must be registered and financial before their first game.
- 3.8 Any player will be entitled to a refund of fees paid should they withdraw on or before the fourth playing date.
