

## **BULLCREEK LEEMING JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB PLAYER ROTATION / SELECTION POLICY**

It is imperative that all Bullcreek Leeming Junior Football Coaches adhere to player rotation policy. The on - field rotation of players is highly recommended by the WA Junior Football Council to enhance the participation and skill development of all players in junior and youth aged football.

The rotation of all players through a variety of positions in a game and throughout the season is designed to allow players to experience the skills, roles and pressures required in different positions and to ensure all players are provided with equal opportunity. The policy recommends that every player in a team should play at least half a game on match days. Further more, every player should experience playing on each of the five lines of field position over a three match period. ( N.B. players should be rotated through a variety of positions on the field in each line, not straight up & down the "spine" or only on the left & right side of the playing arena)

### **COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT**

- 1) I will abide by the A.F.L. coaches code of conduct and ensure I sign the form.
- 2) I will treat all players equally and fairly regardless of size, gender and ability.
- 3) All coaches at Bullcreek Leeming Junior Football Club will be accredited.
- 4) All coaches from Auskick to 12's will produce a team sheet for all games displaying team rotation for all quarters. All players are to be rotated each quarter.
- 5) Team sheet is to be produced on request from Committee Members, parents / guardians.
- 6) Coaches in age group 9 -12's will not be permitted to elevate players from a lower age group if they already have 17 player's available.
- 7) Coaches from 13 - 17's can only elevate players from a lower age group up to a total
- 8) of 21 players. (Beange rule applies)
- 9) All players in age group 13-17's are entitled to play ½ game. All players are to be given equal time on the bench throughout the season. If this does not eventuate coaches will be asked to explain.
- 10) After a period of 3 years all coaches will have their positions reviewed to see if their services will be retained as per the club's risk management policy.
